## Membership Categories

#### Ordinary


#### **Special Purpose Levy**

## Membership Application Process



#### **Membership Application**

- Submit membership application via online application, email or in person.
- Payment of Nomination fee required with lodgement.
- Proposer & Seconder can be added by the office if you do not know any current Club members.

#### **Process Application**

- Membership application and payment are being processed. You become a member in the Waitlist.
- Payment of Membership fee required.
- Applicants' names are placed on the Club's noticeboard for a minimum of fourteen days.

#### **New Members Induction**

- Requirement to attend an Induction session before formal approval.
- Commodore, Vice Commodores or General Manager chairs Induction for approx. 45 mins
- Induction sessions are being held in the 3rd week of each month.
- 1 x Membership Card to gain access through the main gate and for use the Club Restaurant and Bars.
- Restaurant and Bars.
  Permission to use Club facilities once all fees have been paid and induction session has been attended.
- Online log in details to the HYC Members' Portal will be emailed to you within 7 days of completing your induction.

#### Endorsement

- Management Committee meets on the last Monday of the month.

## Boat Facilities

Hillarys Yacht Club has superb facilities for boating enthusiasts with 107 floating pens and 163 fixed pens ranging from 8 metres to 20 metres. Pen options include annual club rentals and long-term leases with subleases.

#### **Annual Club Rental Pens**

Offered for a maximum rental term of one year with an option of renewal. The applicable rate for a pen is comprised of annual pen rental and an annual pen service fee. Rental periods are from 1st May to 30th April. Refunds are not available on pen rental.

#### Long-Term Lease Pens

The remainder of an existing long-term lease may be purchased from a Club member. After completing the transfer of the lease, an annual pen service fee and one-off stamp duty and administration fee are also applicable.

#### **Boat Rack Storage**

Hillarys Marina Lifting Services provides fully secured, undercover boat storage in Perth's northern suburbs. We have 90 custom built boat storage racks housing boats up to 27 feet long and your boat can go from rack to water in less than an hour using our specialised lifting equipment. From there, you're straight out into Hillarys Boat Harbour and the open ocean is just a minute away.

#### **Dinghy Storage**

We offer annual storage for different types of dinghies. Join the Junior section and receive a discounted storage rate.

#### Kayak & Paddle Board Storage

Hillarys Yacht Club offers storage for kayaks and paddle boards to all members.

# **On Water Activities**



#### Angling

The Angling Section is a friendly, family orientated group of members of varying ages and lifestyles who are actively involved in recreational and competitive fishing, whether it be from a boat or beach.

There are weekly fishing trips, monthly Boat Angling competitions, four Beach Competitions and the open Harbour Classic Competition event. The venues for the Beach Competitions will be decided by the members at the Section Meetings and include a weekend away event to places such as Busselton or Cervantes.

The season runs from July to June, culminating with the annual Angling Presentation Dinner.

All eligible Club members are invited to join in the activities of the Angling Section.

#### **Cruising in Company**

Approximately 50 yachts make up the cruising division. Yachts range in size from 24 feet up to about 45 feet. Most are owned and sailed by couples, but several are sailed single-handed. The cruising division attracts those who enjoy cruising in company with other yachts. Members regularly sail to Rottnest, Mindarie, Garden Island, Fremantle, Mandurah and Quindalup. The Cruising in Company Section holds a "Casual Sail" on the first Saturday of every month which is open to all members and any non-members who have registered for a SailPass.





#### Dinghy

The Dinghy Division of the Sailing Section of Hillarys Yacht Club offers enjoyable family and competitive sailing for all ages and experience levels, plus training and coaching on the clear and clean water off Hillarys. We sail types of dinghies that suit juniors, teenagers and adults. Generally, the minimum age is seven years old, but it is dependent on swimming ability. Dinghy racing is held on Saturday mornings during the summer sailing season, extending from October to April, with winter racing from June to August. Races range from Club races through to special regattas.



#### Diving

The Dive section is a very active unit of the Club, both in Club activities and our own social activities.

Our dive activities include weekend day trips to Rottnest Island and exploring the Three Mile Reef system off our back doorstep. The section comprises an almost equal number of cray hunters and photographers. We plan a weekend each year at Rottnest for divers and their partners. We also plan an

annual overseas expedition where possible. Previous trips included the Solomon Islands, Manado in Indonesia, Nusa Lembongan in Indonesia, Christmas and Cocos Islands.

At home, we use the Club boat Alibi for most of our dive excursions - hence the ability to provide low-cost diving.

Club activities also include an annual Harbour Clean-Up day where divers retrieve rubbish for disposal from under the Club jetties, yacht marker retrievals and boat weight retrievals, not to mention requests for keys, sunnies and other fallen item rescues.

Socially, we meet for dinner once a month to ensure that divers' partners are included in the section and regularly congregate at the Club.

#### Keel

30 yachts make up the Keelboat Racing Division, and on average, about 15 yachts compete in any one race. Races are held every Sunday except June until October when races are held every second Sunday. Members from the Keel Racing Section will also go out sailing on Thursday mornings.

With skippers and crew combined, approximately 60 people sail on race days. The fleet is divided into two divisions those yachts less than 30 feet in length and those 30 feet or longer. Races are initially handicapped according to waterline length and performance. The division has its own race officers who start races and take finish times. Our skippers also compete regularly in Yachting Western Australia offshore races off the metropolitan coast and blue water races to Geraldton, Carnarvon and Bunbury.

The division holds several longer races such as the Mindarie and Return, Fairway Race, Commodore's Cup, Australia Day Race, Mariners and Shepherdess Cups and Marmion Reef Race. HYC also hosts the interclub regatta, the Pot of Gold.



#### Paddle

Stay upright on a SUP or kick back in a kayak along with other HYC members in Paddle Division. Regular paddles take place on Saturdays from 2 to 3pm, weather permitting. Meet at The Paddle Shed and launch from the ramp into paddling paradise. Activities include group paddles, fun events, training, demonstrations, dining, making new friends and offsite adventures at other paddle locations. In addition, you can enjoy a solo paddle anytime that suits you. Members are required to have their own SUP or kayak; however, trial paddles can be arranged. Limited storage rack facilities are available for participating members.





#### Powerboating

Hillarys Yacht Club has over 150 member powerboats penned at the Club ranging from 8 metres to 20 metres in length. The Power Section organises activities both on and off the water. These include boat handling, trips away, day and weekend cruises and several social activities. The section endeavours to promote the pleasure of boating activities with fun-loving boaties. Make new friends or revisit old acquaintances at our meetings and activities.
