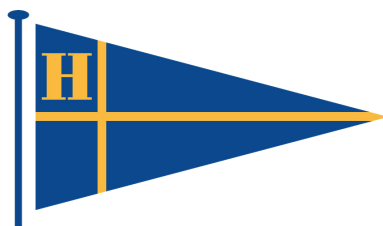

CHAMPAGNE

Louis Roederer 'Collection 245' NV

\$130 per bottle

Champagne, France

Tasting Notes: Citrus zest, yellow peach, pear and apple, brioche and toasted almonds, with a chalky minerality and saline finish.

Louis Roederer is one of the last great independently owned Champagne houses. Collection 245 draws on reserve wines from multiple harvests, including a perpetual reserve aged in oak, and is built around texture and depth rather than simple freshness. Roederer is also the house behind Cristal.

Ayala 'Le Blanc de Blanc Extra-Brut' 2018

\$175 per bottle

Champagne, France

Tasting Notes: Precise, dry and racy with beautiful tension. Pure Chardonnay elegance — crisp green apple, white flowers, crushed chalk and a long mineral finish.

Founded in 1860 and now sister house to Bollinger, Ayala's signature is precision and restraint. This vintage is crafted entirely from Chardonnay sourced from Grand Cru and Premier Cru villages in the Côte des Blancs, Champagne's finest white-grape territory.

WHITE WINE

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2025

\$100 per bottle

Marlborough, New Zealand

Tasting Notes: Explosive tropical fruits — passionfruit, guava, fresh herbs — finishing with a bright, vivid citrus acidity.

Few wines have reshaped a region's identity the way Cloudy Bay did. When it launched in 1985, it put Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc on the global map almost overnight, and remains the benchmark original.

Singlefile 'Old School' Chardonnay 2022

\$120 per bottle

Denmark, Western Australia

Tasting Notes: Buttery, creamy and textural — stone fruit, roasted hazelnut, vanilla cream and a toasty oak backbone.

One of the Great Southern's most exciting boutique producers, Singlefile's 'Old School' is a deliberate homage to the full-throated, oak-forward Australian Chardonnay style, made from cool Denmark subregion fruit.

ROSÉ

Chateau d'Esclans 'Whispering Angel' 2024

\$125 per bottle

Provence, France

Tasting Notes: Delicate strawberries and cream, with a dry, elegantly structured palate of white peach and melon.

Whispering Angel didn't just become the world's best-known premium rosé — it essentially invented the category, produced from ancient Grenache vines since Sacha Lichine acquired Château d'Esclans in 2006.

Campo Viejo 'Gran Reserva' Rioja 2016

\$95 per bottle

Rioja, Spain

Tasting Notes: Classic Rioja elegance — dried cherry, leather, cedar, vanilla and gentle earthiness, with silky tannins.

Under Spanish law, a Gran Reserva must spend a minimum of two years in oak and three further years in bottle before release. Campo Viejo, founded in 1959, is one of Rioja's most celebrated producers, and 2016 is considered one of the region's finest recent vintages.

Catena Zapata Malbec 2023

\$100 per bottle

Mendoza, Argentina

Tasting Notes: Blackberry, blueberry and dark plum with violet, cocoa and warm spice; velvety tannins.

Nicolas Catena Zapata is the man most credited with putting Argentine Malbec on the world stage, planting at high altitude in Mendoza in the late 1980s — a gamble that changed the country's viticultural identity.

Chateau Magnol Haut-Médoc Cru Bourgeois 2020

\$80 per bottle

Haut-Médoc, France

Tasting Notes: Smooth and silky with savoury depth — blackcurrant, cedar, dried herbs and graphite minerality.

The Haut-Médoc is the heartland of Bordeaux's Left Bank. Château Magnol holds the Cru Bourgeois designation, and the 2020 vintage was widely hailed as one of the decade's greatest in Bordeaux.

Glenmore Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

\$100 per bottle

Margaret River, Western Australia

Tasting Notes: Elegant, structured Margaret River Cabernet — cassis, bay leaf, graphite and fine-grained tannins.

In continuous family ownership since 1895, Glenmore's vineyards were established by Ian Bell, previously of the legendary Moss Wood. The 2014 vintage is now approaching a beautiful window of maturity.

Tomfoolery 'Artful Dodger' Shiraz 2024

\$145 per bottle

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Tasting Notes: Opulent and characterful — dark plum, blackberry, smoked meat, cracked pepper and warm spice.

Founded by Ben Chipman, who honed his craft at the iconic Rockford Wines, this Shiraz is sourced from an approximately 80-year-old vineyard in Seppeltsfield.

Peter Lehmann 'Stonewell' Shiraz 2016

\$125 per bottle

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Tasting Notes: Commanding and layered — blackberry conserve, dark chocolate, mocha, liquorice and clove.

Created in 1987 by the legendary Peter Lehmann, Stonewell is made only in exceptional vintages from the oldest, most distinguished Barossa vineyards. The 2016 is considered one of its finest releases.

DESSERT & FORTIFIED

Vasse Felix 'Cane Cut' Semillon 2024

\$75 per bottle

Margaret River, Western Australia (375ml)

Tasting Notes: Luscious and fragrant — lemon curd, pineapple, apricot, honeysuckle and marmalade.

Vasse Felix is Margaret River's founding winery, established in 1967. The cane-cut method dehydrates and concentrates the Semillon naturally on the vine for a vivid, fresh style of dessert wine.

Morris Classic Tawny NV

\$70 per bottle

Rutherglen, Victoria (500ml)

Tasting Notes: Rich and warming — roasted nuts, caramel, raisin, spice, toffee and marzipan.

The Morris family has made wine in Rutherglen since 1859, using a solera-style blending system that builds extraordinary complexity over decades. Widely regarded as Australia's finest fortified producer.



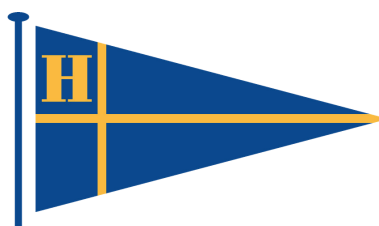
