[DP]	Denotes a rule of which the penalty is at the discretion of the race committee and may be less than disqualification.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS.
- 1.2 The Pot of Gold and Shepherdess Cup Races will be governed by the ORWA 2024-2025 Sailing Instructions. These races are classed as Category 4, as defined in section 2 of the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1.
- 1.3 Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be issued for the Pot of Gold and Shepherdess Cup Races.
- 1.4 The Super 30 series and the Dash for Cash will be governed by the HYC Pot of Gold Weekend Sailing Instructions. These races are classed as Category 6, as defined in section 2 of the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1. These races will have an escort safety boat.
- 1.5 RRS 44.1 – Taking a penalty – is changed for all Divisions so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.
- 1.6 Appendix T – Arbitration shall apply.

2 Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 The HYC Pot of Gold Weekend Sailing Instructions will be available on the Hillarys Yacht Club web site, www.hillarysyachtclub.com.au no later than 31st December 2024.

3 Communications

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located on the Hillarys Yacht Club website, www.hillarysyachtclub.com.au under Water Sports, Regattas, Pot of Gold.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF channels 16 and 72, as well as any other channel(s) that maybe specified in the SI's and SSI's.
- 3.3 On the water, the Race Committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio on the Race Channel.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 3.5 A pre-race briefing for the Dash for Cash will be held at Hillarys Yacht Club on Thursday January 16 at 1800.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 All financial members of invited Clubs and/or Class Associations are eligible to compete.
- 4.2 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:
 - a) If, by the closing date, less than 5 entries are received in any division, the OA may change the eligibility requirements.

- b) Yachts affected will have the option of confirming their entry under the new eligibility requirement or having their fee refunded.
 - c) The OA shall have the right, in the interest of fair sailing, to allocate a yacht to a particular division.
- 4.3 Eligible boats for the Dash for Cash and Super 30 series shall enter online via the HYC website (www.hillarysyachtclub.com.au) under Water Sports, Regattas, with accompanied required fee prior to 1700 Monday 13 January 2025.
- 4.4 Eligible boats for the Pot of Gold shall enter via the ORWA web site (www.oceanracingwa.com.au/competitor-information/race-entry/), with accompanied required fee prior to 1700 Monday 13 January 2025.
- 4.5 Entry is at the absolute discretion of the OA.
- 4.6 Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

5 Event Categories

- 5.1 The following event categories are provided for the Dash for Cash and Super 30 series of races.

Division	Description	Handicap
Dash for Cash Division 1	Yachts with a length overall greater than 9.5 metres, or at the Race Committee's discretion, sailing the Dash for Cash from Fremantle to Hillarys.	PHS
Dash for Cash Division 2	Yachts with a length overall less than 9.5 metres, or at the Race Committee's discretion, sailing the Dash for Cash from Fremantle to Hillarys.	PHS
Dash for Cash Division 3 (Jib and Main)	Yachts that shall not fly a spinnaker at any time during the race, sailing the Dash for Cash from Fremantle to Hillarys.	PHS
Sports Boats	All sports boats, sailing the Dash for Cash from Fremantle to Hillarys.	PHS
Super 30's	Planing Keel boats, sailing a series of up to 5 races comprising 2-3 windward/leeward races, the Dash for Cash race and a return race Hillarys to Fremantle.	IRC Standard

6 Fees

- 6.1 The entry fee for boats entering the Dash for Cash alone shall be \$60.00.
- 6.2 The entry fee for the Pot of Gold and Shepherdess Cup shall be \$150.00.
- 6.3 The entry fee Super 30 series of 5 races, including the Dash for Cash, shall be \$150.00.

- 7.1 A detailed race schedule and courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

7.2 Conducting the Super 30 Races will be undertaken at the discretion of the OA allowing for the scheduled starts of the other weekend races.

8 Racing Area

8.1 The racing area will be the waters of the Indian Ocean, from Fremantle to Hillarys.

9 Courses

9.1 Detailed course will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9.2 Super 30 courses will comprise:

Race 1	1 to 3 laps of a Windward / Leward course with legs set between 0.8NM and 1.5NM. The start and finish will be in the vicinity of Hall Bank beacon.
Race 2	The Dash for Cash race from Fremantle to Hillarys.
Races 3 & 4	1 to 3 laps of a Windward / Leward course with legs set between 0.8NM and 1.5NM. The start and finish will be in the waters off Sorrento Beach.
Race 5	A race from Hillarys to Fremantle. The start will be in the waters Sorrento Beach. The finish line will be in the vicinity of the Fremantle South Mole lighthouse.

9.3 The Dash for Cash start will be in the vicinity of Hall Bank Beacon. The finish line will be a line between the HYC Race Control tower and a red flag situated approximately 300m north.

10 Scoring

10.1 The Low Points scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

10.2 For the Super 30's, three races are required to constitute a series. When 5 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her 1 worst score. When fewer than 5 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

11 Support Person Vessels

11.1 [DP] Support person vessels shall be marked with white and green flags.

12 Berthing

12.1 [DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned pens whilst they are in the Hillarys Harbour.

13 Risk Statement

13.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

14 Insurance

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or equivalent. By taking part in the regatta owners are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.

15 Prizes

- 15.1 Pennants will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each of the Super 30 races using IRC Club handicaps.
- 15.2 Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for the Dash for Cash for PHS handicaps.
- 15.3 Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for the Pot of Gold for PHS and IRC handicaps.
- 15.4 Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for the Super 30 Series.
